**RE: A.R.S. 15-232 Semiannual Report to the Arizona Legislature from
Adult Education Services: July 1, 2015 – December 1, 2015**

Of the 12,386 people who applied for instruction in Arizona Adult Education during the reporting period, 735 people (5% percent) were denied instruction because they failed to provide acceptable evidence of citizenship or legal residence in the United States.

At the time of enrollment, ALL students must provide documented proof of legal residency. To ensure compliance with ARS 15-232 C., ADE staff conducts on-site inspections of student enrollment records annually.

The following table provides current and historical state totals for the number of people who are waitlisted for classes in each AES service area, who applied for classes, and who were denied enrollment in accordance with ARS 15-232 C.
