**Article I – NAME AND PURPOSE**

**Section A – Name**

The name of the organization shall be Future Educators of Arizona (Ed Professions).

**Section B – Purpose**

- The purpose of this organization shall be to publish train teachers.
- To allow the student to teach others and fundraise for the community.

**Article II – OFFICERS**

**Section A – Officers**

This organization shall have the following elected officers for each grade level: President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

**Section B – Duties of Class Members:**

1. To help get necessary items needed to teach in classrooms and participate in community outreach.
2. To promote FEA and attend events.

**Section C – Selection of Class Council Representatives.**

1. Shall be chosen by the teacher, and voted upon by the class.

**ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP**

**Section A – Members**

1. Students must be enrolled at Cienega.
2. Students must complete their duties.

**Section B – Selection of Members**

1. Selection of members is decided upon the previous year.
2. The teacher and previous years class choose the members.
3. Should a vacancy occur officers may be filled at the discretion of the Advisor(s).

**ARTICLE IV – RESPONSIBILITIES OF CLASS OFFICERS**

**Section A – Overall**

1. Must attend all scheduled classes and meeting.
2. Must be willing to participate fully in all fundraising activities.
3. Represent the program in a positive manner.
4. Must abide by all rules and regulations set forth by
  - a. The Vail School District
  - b. Cienega High School
  - c. Cienega High School Student Council Program

**Section B – Character**

Members of FEA are expected to have and continue to display the following characteristics. Members who do not display these characteristics will be subject to probation or dismissal from the program.

1. Must be honest
2. Must willingly to accomplish their given tasks.

3. Must attend class regularly.
4. Must have a good general attitude
5. Represent the program in a positive manner.
6. Must not drink alcohol, use drugs, or participate in any activity that would be degrading to Newspaper.

#### **ARTICLE V – FEA REQUIREMENTS**

##### Section A – Standards

1. The Class Advisor has the power to prohibit a member from attending any activity or continue as a class officer for any reason such as bad behavior, bad attitude, failing Ed Professions or suspensions.

#### **ARTICLE V111- ATTENDENCE**

##### Section A- Excuses
