

**Constitution:**  
**Ironwood High School Future Educators of Arizona**

**Article I. Name and Affiliation**

- Section 1. The name of this organization shall be the Ironwood High School Future Educators of Arizona.
- Section 2. This organization will affiliate with the National Future Educators of Arizona organization.

**Article II. Purpose**

The purpose of this organization shall be to:

- Section 1. Provide high school students with opportunities to explore teaching as a career option.
- Section 2. Help students gain a realistic understanding of the nature of education and the role of the teacher.
- Section 3. Provide its members with knowledge and experiences that develop qualities and attitudes basic to successful teaching.

**Article III. Membership**

- Section 1. Membership in this organization shall be limited to students currently enrolled in the Future Teachers Academy at Ironwood High School.

**Article IV. Officers**

- Section 1. The officers of this organization shall be: President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer.
- Section 2. The officers shall be elected by a majority vote. Vacancies occurring during the school year shall be filled by a special election held at the next regular meeting.
- Section 3. The President shall preside at the meetings of this organization.
- Section 4. The Vice President shall preside in the absence of the President.

Section 5. The Secretary shall keep the official minutes of the meetings, conduct correspondence and maintain organization records.

Section 6. The Treasurer shall receive and disburse all funds and keep an accurate account of receipts and disbursements in accordance with school and district regulations.

### **Article V. Sponsor**

Section 1. Organization activities shall be subject to the approval of the FTA sponsor and the school Principal.

Section 2. The Sponsor must be the teacher assigned to teach the Future Teachers Academy class/es.

Section 3. The Sponsor or another designated adult shall be present at all organization meetings and activities.

### **Article VI. Meetings**

Section 1. Regular meetings of the organization shall be held to conduct business and evaluate its effectiveness in achieving its purposes as stated above.

### **Article VII. Bylaws**

Section 1. The organization may adopt and amend Bylaws to amplify sections of this Constitution.
