

# MILLENNIUM HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION PROFESSIONS

## CONSTITUTION

Revised Nov 23, 2010

### PREAMBLE

#### Section 1. Purpose

The purpose of this organization is to:

1. Become familiarized with education as well as the culture that exists in a school
2. Develop a liking as well as a respect for the education professions
3. Learn and understand the origins of education
4. Learn and perfect the "art" of teaching

### ARTICLE I – NAME

#### Section 1. Name

The name of our organization shall be the Future Educators of America (FEA)

### ARTICLE II – MEMBERSHIP

#### Section 1. Membership

Members will comprise of those students who are regularly enrolled in Millennium High School and shares the interests and supports the goals of the core group.

Members are accepted with or with out majority vote by the organizational government. To prevent possible problems and the limiting of available activities, the numbers of members will be unlimited not including the government.

### ARTICLE III—ORGANIZATION OF THE GOVERNMENT

#### Section 1. Structure of the Government

The Government consists of the following individuals:

A. President--The President will call special meetings of the Club. He/she shall preside over all meetings of the Club. In the event of the office of the president becomes vacant, it shall be filled by the Vice President. The president must have completed one semester of an FEA class and be enrolled in a second FEA class.

B. Vice President--The Vice President shall assume the powers and duties of the President in the event of his/her absence. He/she shall assist the President and Secretary/Treasure in their performance of his/her duties. He/she shall succeed to the President if that office becomes vacant during the term of the year. The Vice President must have completed one semester of an FEA class and be enrolled in a second FEA class.

C. Secretary/Treasurer--The third officer shall hold the position of Recording Secretary/Treasurer and shall keep a record of all meetings of the club and shall, upon request, read the minutes of any previous meeting. He/she shall also be in charge of the Education Professions Club funds and shall be reasonable to submit a financial statement at such times as requested.

D. Officer at Large—An officer at large will be appointed by the Advisor(s) and the three elected officers to be a representative for each of the FEA classes for the duration of one semester.

ARTICLE IV: SELECTION OF OFFICERS  
TERM OF OFFICE AND QUALIFICATIONS FOR MEMBERS

Section 1. Election Process

Officers are elected through an application process and a simple majority vote.

Section 2. Length of Term

President, Vice President, and Secretary/Treasurer Officers will remain active until the beginning of the next school year.

An officer at large will be appointed by the Advisor(s) and the three elected officers to be a representative for each of the FEA classes for the duration of one semester.

Section 3. Qualifications of office selected

Officers will attend club meetings which are held separate from the class.

ARTICLE V: NOMINATIONS AND ELECTIONS OF OFFICERS FROM MEMBERS

Section 1. Nomination processes

Club members will apply for office through an application/interview process.

Section 2. Election process

Club members who have successfully completed their application/interview process, will have their name put upon a ballot.

All members of the club will vote for their choice of First, Second, Third, and Fourth officer.

ARTICLE VI: MEETINGS

Section 1. Regularly Scheduled Meetings

Meetings will be held the second Tuesday of the month.

Section 2. Additional Meetings

Additional meetings may be scheduled during the month.
