

REQUIREMENTS FOR
SUBSTITUTE, K – 12 CERTIFICATE
ARIZONA DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION – CERTIFICATION UNIT

Certificate entitles the holder to substitute in the temporary absence of a regular contract teacher. An individual who holds a valid Arizona Teaching or Administrator certificate shall not be required to hold a Substitute certificate to be employed as a substitute teacher. An individual holding only a Substitute certificate shall not be assigned a contract teaching position and shall be limited to teaching 120 days in the same school each school year. Substitute teaching may not be used to waive the student teaching practicum.

➤ **SUBSTITUTE, PRE K – 12 CERTIFICATE**

All requirements for the Substitute Certificate must be met. Certificate is valid for six years and renewable by reapplication. **Fees are not refundable.**

1. A Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution. Official transcript(s) required.
