Monitoring Visits

- ❖ Corrective Action Follow-Up visits have been set up and you should have received notification.
 - Letters are sent to the Superintendents with ELL Coordinators receiving a copy.

Title III Grant Applications

- ❖ Title III allocations are nearly ready...
 - **ALEAT Continuous Improvement Plan** should be in the system when you apply for Title III
 - Supplemental, not Supplanting for all Title III items- above and beyond what you're providing for other students, not required by law, and not previously paid for with other funding sources
 - Remember **Professional Development** **MUST** be included in Title III
 - New detailed codes in GME for Capital Outlay

Title III Grant Applications Continued

- ❖ New **Additional Assurances** must be completed in the “required documents” section
- ❖ Consortium applications have **2 required** packets
- ❖ ALL LEAs and Consortia are being asked to break out their **medical** from the **other benefits**. Include two lump sums per salary benefit please (\$xxxx medical + 19.8% or \$xxxx medical + \$xxxx other benefits)

Title III Grant Applications Continued

- ❖ Come see the “***Top Ten Tips: Understanding Title III and the SEI Budget***” breakout session for all you need to know about funding for ELLs.
- ❖ Completion Reports
 - Should match what items were on the approved application
 - Application revisions may be recommended prior to completion report approval
 - Overspending by 10% or \$1000 is allowable at the discretion of the program area
 - Look out for warning letters
