A word that takes the place of a noun



## Verb

A word that shows action



## Adverb

A lonely word that tells how the action happens



## Preposition

A word that goes everywhere with her best friend, Noun, to tell when or where



## Conjunction

A word that is used to join words together, like glue



## Interjection

A word that is used to show strong feeling



# Grammar Wall

## Adjective

A word that describes a noun to tell:

- what kind
- which one
- how many

## Noun

A word that names:

- a person
- a place
- a thing
- an idea

## Pronoun

A word that takes the place of a noun

## Verb

A word that shows:

- physical action
- mental action
- being or state of being

## Adverb

A word that describes a verb, an adverb, or an adjective to tell:

- where
- when
- how

## Preposition

A word that describes relationships between other words to tell:

- when
- where

## Conjunction

A word that is used to join:

- words
- phrases
- clauses

## Interjection

A word or phrase that shows strong feels or emotions

The Parts of Speech should be placed in this order on the Grammar Wall.

# Grammar Wall

## **Adjective**

A word that is used to describe a noun or pronoun, telling what kind, which one, or how many is an **adjective**.

## **Noun**

A word that names a person, place, thing or idea is a **noun**.

## **Pronoun**

A word that is used in place of a noun is a **pronoun**.

## **Verb**

A word that shows physical or mental action, being, or state of being is a **verb**.

## **Adverb**

A word that is used to describe a verb, an adjective, or another adverb is an **adverb**. It tells where, how, or when, and many adverbs in English end in **-ly**.

## **Preposition**

A word that shows the relationship of a noun or pronoun to another word is a **preposition**.

## **Conjunction**

A word that joins/connects words or groups of words is a **conjunction**.

## **Interjection**

A word or phrase that is used to express strong emotion is an **interjection**.

The Parts of Speech should be placed in this order on the Grammar Wall.
