# School Emergency Response Plans


- ARS 15-341 (A)(32) requires district schools to meet the Minimum Requirements for ERPs
- Minimum Requirements
  - Developed in 2000; modified in 2006
  - Minimal revisions in 2013
- New Guidance/Template
  - Developed in 2000; modified in 2006
  - Significant revisions in 2013
  - Highly recommended but not required

# Minimum Requirements

## 1. NIMS Compliance

- ICS utilization
- Training for those with an ICS function

## 2. ERP Contents

- Introduction
  - District-level signature page with local public health, law enforcement, emergency management, and fire
- Purpose
- Activation Authority and Communication



# Minimum Requirements

- ERP Contents, cont.
  - Situation Overview
    - Quantification of campus facilities and population
    - Hazard analysis with “lead agencies”
  - Direction, Control and Coordination
    - ICS org chart
    - Procedures for functions
    - Quick reference guides for the classroom
  - ERP Attachments



# Minimum Requirements

## 3. Plan Development and Maintenance

- Annual review, training, drills, debriefs
- Drill requirement streamlined
- Collaboration with lead agencies
- Share as appropriate with parents
