1. Course Mapping Process

Utilizes CourseWalk™ to facilitate the matching of local course codes to state or national course code standards

Pre-loaded templates are available that are filled-out for LEAs adopting the Arizona Course Catalog

2. State Report Manager (SRM) Data Extracts

State Report Manager is the ESP tool that executes the Student-Teacher-Course Connection


File extracts uploaded from SIS system to SRM and data verification

LEA Early Adopter Questions

1. Is it possible for more than one person to have access?
 - Yes More than one person can be logged in at the same time.
2. Are we reporting only our core courses or do we also have to report elective courses?
 - All credit courses need to be included.
3. Can there be more than one course in our catalog with the same state ID
 - Yes. You can have multiple courses mapped to a single state ID. More than one local course may map to the same state course.

LEA Early Adopter Questions

4. Do we need to fill out the Needs Assessment Survey?
 - Yes all LEAs are required to fill out the Needs Assessment Survey. This information will help the project team to determine your needs so that we can best support you,
5. Our Elementary schools are set-up as each grade level using one year long course. For example first grade uses just one course titled, "First Grade". Will we need to set-up each grade level with a course of Math, Social Studies, etc.?
 - Yes. The requirement is to assign each elementary course subject for each student and each teacher
