Krista Cox, PhD

The Arizona Association of School Psychologists recognizes the importance of relationships between administrators and school psychologists. Cox received her bachelor's degree from Arizona State University, master's degree from Northern Arizona University, and earned her doctorate degree from Grand Canyon University.

During recent A+ School judging, a student with Autism shared, "In case you can't tell, I have Autism, but I like it here at Campo. They accept me as I am and don't treat me any different here." Her colleague noted that this statement powerfully portrays the atmosphere and community Cox has created at Campo Verde High School.
