

Arizona Report of Public Agency Performance on Secondary Transition Requirements

Indicator 13: Secondary Transition Requirements

Percent of youth with IEPs aged 16 and above with an IEP that includes appropriate measurable postsecondary goals that are annually updated and based upon an age appropriate transition assessment, transition services, including courses of study, that will reasonably enable the student to meet those postsecondary goals, and annual IEP goals related to the student's transition services. There also must be evidence that the student was invited to the IEP Team meeting where transition services are to be discussed and evidence that, if appropriate, a representative of any participating agency was invited to the IEP Team meeting with the prior consent of the parent or student who has reached the age of majority.

Measurement

The data are from the ADE/ESS monitoring results and reflect the status of each public education agency (PEA) at the time of the on-site monitoring.

Data

The data are from school year 2010–2011. The data are the percentage of student files reviewed during the monitoring that met all the secondary transition requirements.
