Federal Special Education Child Count Checklist

There are several reasons that explain why a student would be listed on the SPED71-1 or SPED71-2 report, yet be excluded from the SPED07. Please consult the checklist below before reporting any discrepancies between the SPED07 and your actual list of students receiving services on October 1.

- The student was not receiving SPED services on October 1.
- The student was less than 3 years old on October 1.
- The student reached his/her 22nd birthday on or before October 1.
- The student's SPED School Concurrency is indicated as "Secondary."
- The student's district of residence (DOR CTDS) is other than the district in which the student receives services.
- The student's Special Education Service Participation record was added to SAIS after the most recent update of the SPED07.¹
- The student's records were failing as a result of SAIS Student Integrity processing for the October 1 Federal Special Education business rules (Oct 1 FED SPED Integrity) at the time of the most recent update of the SPED07.²

¹ In such cases, the student's records would be expected to appear on the SPED07 the next time it is updated.

² In such cases, if corrections are submitted to SAIS to successfully resolve the integrity failure prior to the next SPED07 data extract, the student's records would be expected to appear on the SPED07 the next time it is updated.
