



# CALL FOR ARTWORK FROM STUDENTS WITH IEPs to Design Arizona's Fifteenth Annual Transition Conference Brochure Cover *Connecting for Success: Shared Expectations, Responsibilities, and Outcomes*

## Arizona's Fifteenth Annual Transition Conference August 24–26, 2015

Arizona's Fifteenth Annual Transition Conference Planning Committee is seeking artwork created by students with IEPs for this year's conference brochure. **Any student currently enrolled in an Arizona public education agency (PEA) or approved private school who is identified with a disability and is between the ages of 14 and 22 is eligible to submit an entry.** The first-place winning entry will be used on the brochure cover. Other winning entries will be used throughout the conference brochure, and all student entries will be acknowledged by the Arizona Department of Education/Exceptional Student Services. The theme, *Connecting for Success: Shared Expectations, Responsibilities, and Outcomes*, reflects the importance of making connections with the people, agencies, and resources that support engagement, independence, and successful post-school outcomes for students with disabilities. The cover artist winner and his or her family will be offered scholarships to attend the conference.

### Artwork Entry Submission Rules

**Design Criteria:**

Paper Type: ANY KIND

Size: ANY SIZE up to a MAXIMUM of 11" X 17"

No limit to artwork's colors or media used to create the work, i.e., acrylic, oil, watercolor, enamel, crayon, chalk, markers, pencil, computer-generated, or any combination.

**Conference Display:**

*Please indicate whether ADE/ESS can store the submitted artwork before displaying it at the conference. Otherwise, if student artwork is returned after the cover contest, artwork intended for display must be resubmitted per the general Call for Artwork.*

**Submission Deadline:**

All student artwork entries must be received by **March 6, 2015**. E-mail, mail, or deliver artwork to:

**Labeling:**

Each entry **MUST** include a label affixed to the back clearly marked with the student's name, age, school district, and PEA/approved private school information. The entry contact person's name, e-mail address, mailing address, and phone number must also be clearly indicated on the label. If the entry is e-mailed to us, include the above information in the e-mail. **Entries without contact information cannot be considered for the brochure.**

**Parent/Guardian/Student Approval:**

It is assumed that all necessary approval for the use of student artwork will have been obtained by the PEA or approved private school submitting the entry. Any photos of students must include a photo release.

**Self-Addressed Return Packaging:**

All entries must include appropriate self-addressed return packaging.
