

Arizona Report of Public Agency Performance on Post School Outcomes

Indicator 14: Post School Outcomes

Percent of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, and were:

14A. Enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school.

14B. Enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school.

14C. Enrolled in higher education or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment within one year of leaving high school.

Measurement

14A. Percent enrolled in higher education = number of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school and were enrolled in higher education within one year of leaving high school, divided by the number of respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, times 100.

14B. Percent enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school = number of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school and were enrolled in higher education or competitively employed within one year of leaving high school, divided by the number of respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, times 100.

14C. Percent enrolled in higher education, or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment = number of youth who are no longer in secondary school, had IEPs in effect at the time they left school and were enrolled in higher education, or in some other postsecondary education or training program; or competitively employed or in some other employment, divided by the number of respondent youth who are no longer in secondary school and had IEPs in effect at the time they left school, times 100.

Data

Each public education agency (PEA) in the assigned cohort year must administer the Post School Outcome survey to all special education students who exited the prior school year. PEAs with a student population of 50,000 or more must administer the survey every year. The survey responses were collected from youth or family members between July 1 and September 30, 2013 about students who were out of school for at least one year.

A PEA is listed with an asterisk (*) when it had less than 10 students who exited the prior school year. In these instances, the data are not reported to ensure confidentiality.
