Youth & Family Scholarships



A limited number of scholarships are available.

To qualify for a scholarship, applicants must be a(n):

- ◆ Arizona resident
- ◆ Youth/young adult between the ages of 14 and 22 years with a documented disability
- ◆ Family member of a student with a disability; or a
- ◆ Personal assistant to a youth/young adult attending the conference.

Special Notes:

- ◆ In order to ensure that scholarship funding is fairly distributed, the number of scholarships offered per family may be limited.
- ◆ In the event that requests for scholarships exceed available funding, your name will be placed on a waiting list.
- ◆ Scholarship recipients may be responsible for some of their own travel expenses, as well as some dinner costs.
