BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Matt J. Bustoz held a Substitute Teaching certificate valid from February 9, 2000 through February 24, 2006, an Emergency Teaching certificate valid from October 15, 2001 through July 1, 2002 and an Emergency Teaching certificate valid from August 15, 2003 through July 1, 2004.

On September 4, 2013, in the Maricopa County Superior Court, **Matt J. Bustoz** pled guilty to four counts of Sexual Conduct with a Minor and is required to register as a sex offender. These convictions constitute unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-550 and warrant the immediate and permanent revocation of his Arizona teaching certificate. A.R.S. §15-203(B) (5) provides that the State Board of Education may impose disciplinary action after the suspension or expiration of the certificate.
