**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

**Jordan P. Doneskey** holds a Provisional Career and Technical Education certificate valid from August 16, 2012 through January 20, 2014, a Standard Elementary Education certificate valid from July 26, 2012 through July 26, 2017 and a Provisional Secondary Education certificate valid from January 20, 2011 through August 16, 2015.

On March 26, 2013, in Maricopa County Superior Court, Jordan Doneskey pled guilty to three counts of Attempted Sexual Conduct with a Minor. These convictions constitute unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. §15-550 and warrant the immediate and permanent revocation of his Arizona teaching certificates.
