BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Timothy P. White held a Teaching Intern certificate valid from June 21, 2011 through June 21, 2012.

On April 17, 2013, in Maricopa County Superior Court, Timothy P. White pled guilty to Attempted Sexual Abuse. This conviction constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. §15-550 and warrants the immediate and permanent revocation of his Arizona teaching certificate.

A.R.S. §15-203(B) (5) provides that the State Board of Education may impose disciplinary action after the suspension or expiration of a certificate.
