BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Dina M. Breaux holds a Standard Secondary Education (7-12) certificate valid December 8, 2010, through December 6, 2016.

On June 13, 2012, the Arizona Department of Public Safety (“DPS”) notified the Investigative Unit of the State Board of Education (“Board”) that Ms. Breaux’s fingerprint clearance card was suspended for an arrest or charge of misdemeanor marijuana-possession/use.

On June 26, 2013, the Investigative Unit notified Ms. Breaux of the intent of the State Board of Education to file a complaint seeking disciplinary action against her teaching certificate. After discussing the matter with Ms. Breaux and her legal counsel, she chose to surrender her teaching certificate.

On July 11, 2013, the Investigative Unit received Ms. Breaux’s notarized affidavit surrendering her teaching certificate.
