**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Migrant Education Program (MEP) is a federally funded state-operated program under the No Child Left Behind Act (NCLB) that provides supplemental program services to Migrant Education eligible children, ages 3 through 21 of seasonal or temporary agricultural workers. The program delivers services primarily through Local Education Agencies (LEAs) that design programs to meet the un-served needs of children residing in their area.

The Arizona Department of Education, Migrant Program Office recently received from the U.S. Department of Education, MEP office, a onetime supplemental allocation of \$56,682.00, which is in addition to the regular Fy13-14 MEP allocation of \$6,470,071. 00 to enhance Migrant Program services to qualified students and to further the mission of the MEP program in Arizona.

These funds will be administered pursuant to the No Child Left Behind Act, Title I, Part C, and Federal Migrant Program regulations.
