BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

John Frank Todorich holds a Standard Elementary Education, (K-8) Certificate valid from May 31, 2012, through July 6, 2018; a Principal Certificate, valid from May 31, 2012, through July 6, 2018; and a Substitute Certificate valid from November 5, 1987. through July 1, 2099.

On September 10, 2012, Washington Elementary School District (“District”) notified the Arizona State Board of Education (“Board”) of allegations that Mr. Todorich was arrested on September 7, 2012, by Phoenix Police Department, on a charge of Luring a Minor for Sexual Exploitation. On September 7, 2012, Mr. Todorich was placed on administrative leave by the District.

On August 21, 2013, the Investigative Unit notified John Todorich of the intent of the State Board of Education to file a complaint seeking disciplinary action against his teaching certificate. Mr. Todorich chose to surrender his teaching certificate.

On October 23, 2013, the Investigative Unit received Mr. Todorich’s notarized affidavit in which he surrendered his certificates.
