**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

**Dawn M. Baca-Fanion** held a Standard Elementary Education Certificate valid from May 3, 2006 through February 19, 2012.

On May 4, 2010, in the Maricopa County Superior Court, **Dawn M. Baca-Fanion** pled guilty to Child Abuse. This conviction constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to A.R.S. § 15-550 and warrant the immediate and permanent revocation of her Arizona teaching certificate. A.R.S. §15-203(B) (5) provides that the State Board of Education may impose disciplinary action after the suspension or expiration of the certificate.
