


## System of Behavioral Supports 3 Tiers

The diagram below shows the curricula and other supports most commonly utilized within the three-tier framework.



### Intensive Level of Supports

- Intensive academic support
- Intensive social skills teaching
- Individual behavior management plans
- Family involvement
- Multi-agency collaboration (wrap-around) services
- Alternatives to suspensions and expulsions
- Community and service learning

### Targeted Level of Supports

- Increased academic support
- Increased and targeted social skills teaching
- Increased monitoring and reinforcement systems
- Self management techniques
- Family involvement
- Mentoring programs
- Alternatives to suspensions and expulsions
- Community and service learning

### Universal Level of Supports

- School behavior expectations instruction
- Universal social skills training
- Active supervision and monitoring
- Positive reinforcement systems
- Firm, fair, and corrective discipline
- Effective classroom management
- Improved environmental arrangements
- Family involvement
