**Arizona's Eleventh Annual Transition Conference
October 3–5, 2011**

Arizona's Eleventh Annual Transition Conference Planning Committee is seeking artwork created by students with IEPs for display at this year's conference. All student artwork will be acknowledged by the Arizona Department of Education/Exceptional Student Services. The theme, *Imagine It, Plan It, Do It!* is reflective of intra- and interagency collaborative efforts to improve postsecondary outcomes for youth and young adults with disabilities in the areas of employment, education, training, and adult living.

Artwork Entry Submission Rules

- **Any student currently enrolled in an Arizona public education agency (PEA) or approved private school, identified with a disability, and between the ages of 14 through 22 is eligible to submit an entry.***
- Sponsoring agencies/PEAs must obtain all necessary approval for participating youth under age 18.
- **Submit artwork in one of two ways:**
 - 1) Mail artwork by **September 23, 2011**, to Jeannette Zemeida at the address below; or
 - 2) Bring artwork to the conference site (Talking Stick Resort, 9800 E. Indian Bend Rd., Scottsdale, AZ) between **2 p.m. and 5 p.m. on October 2, 2011.**

DESIGN CRITERIA:

Artwork Form/Medium: ALL FORMS of artwork will be considered (e.g., pottery, papier mâché, sculptures, weavings, fabric, masks); NO LIMIT applies to colors or sources used to create colors.

Size: ANY SIZE up to a MAXIMUM of 18" X 22"

Labeling:

Each entry **MUST** include a label affixed on the back clearly marked with the student's name, age, school, and grade. The entry contact person's name, e-mail address, mailing address, and phone number must also be clearly labeled.

Self-Addressed Return Packaging:

All entries must include appropriate self-addressed return packaging.

Special Note:

Neither the Committee nor its sponsors will assume responsibility for lost, stolen, or damaged artwork. The Committee reserves the right to reject any submission based on content, if deemed inappropriate.
