### Child Find ~ Birth to Three Referrals

The birth to three referral to Arizona Early Intervention Program (AzEIP) process is most effective when districts have one main contact point for referrals and tracking. Through required annual district Child Find trainings, contact information for that person is shared with all staff. The contact person may be an administrative assistant or member of the early childhood/special education team who has been trained in the process. That process includes taking referrals and faxing them to AzEIP as well as implementing the required follow up procedures explained on the form and in the Child Find IGA. A notebook or folder with the *Arizona Child Find Tracking Form: Referral from a PEA (District or Charter School)* forms must be maintained for monitoring purposes. If there are no referrals, the monitoring team will look for evidence that the process is in place. Evidence may include a notebook with blank forms and a contact person who can explain the process. **Referral Contact Information** Attached are AzEIP provider lists for Maricopa, Yuma, Navajo and Apache Counties. These programs take referrals, complete the evaluation and eligibility for AzEIP and act as the ongoing provider for children who are eligible for AzEIP but not DDD or ASDB. Future updated referral lists will be available near the end of April and will be forwarded to you.
