

Intel® Teach Program Master Teacher (MT) Guidelines

Master Teachers (MTs), selected by the Local Education Agency (LEA), are experienced in integrating technology into curriculum. In addition, MTs must be competent in using a word processing application, e-mail, and Internet navigation. MTs undergo comprehensive instruction and curriculum review by certified Senior Trainers (STs). Upon successful completion of the instruction for Master Teachers, MTs then recruit and deliver professional development to Participant Teachers (PTs) in their area.

Master Teacher benefits

- MTs receive free instruction and review of integration of technology into their curriculum.
- MTs create a complete project and/or unit plan ready for student use.
- MTs receive a certificate of completion documenting their hours of professional development.
- MTs are provided all instructional materials to teach colleagues, including ongoing updates to Web resources, at no charge.
- MTs have the option to purchase continuing education credits from providers. [Click here for information on credit opportunities available*](#).
- MTs may be eligible for quarterly technology equipment drawings
- MTs have the opportunity to participate in multiple professional development offerings to continue enhancing their technology integration skills.
- Other benefits may be provided by the Local Education Agency (LEA) or Intel Teach Affiliate (ITA).

General eligibility and requirements for MT participation

- MTs must commit to recruit and train a minimum of 10 PTs within one year of completing an MT course.
- MTs must be K-12 teachers in an LEA participating in the Intel Teach Program.
- MTs are identified by the LEA. Individual teachers may not apply directly.
- MTs must attend and fully participate in the required classroom hours of instruction and curriculum review (for each professional development offering they attend).
- MTs must demonstrate competency in word processing, spreadsheet, and presentation software, e-mail, Internet navigation, and integration of computer technology with existing curriculum.
- MTs are required to deliver the course to PTs according to the Delivery Guidelines and agenda options provided.
