Characteristics and quality practices for typical and atypical behaviors of young children	<b>EED 222</b> Introduction to the Exceptional Young Child (3 credits) OR <b>EED 270</b> Early Learning Development	These courses deal with related issues from birth through age 8. Includes field experience.
Child growth and development including health , safety and nutrition	<b>CFS 176</b> Child Development (3 credits) OR <b>EED 215</b> Early Learning: Health, Safety, Nutrition and Fitness (3 credits)	The course encompasses the period from conception to adolescence Includes field experience.
