REAUTHORIZATION OF ESEA

- NCLB is still in place - 3 year (or more?) extension
- *Blueprint* released March 2010
 - Four assurances from RTTT dominate
 - Standards and assessments
 - Great teachers, great leaders
 - Robust data systems
 - Support for struggling schools
- Current status
 - House
 - Senate

FISCAL ISSUES


- ⦿ State and national budget constraints
- ⦿ FY11 (current federal fiscal year) CR expires Friday (House passed 3-week extension yesterday)
 - Contains cuts to education programs
 - Looming federal government shut down?
 - Administration vowing to protect Title I and IDEA
 - ⦿ President's new budget based on *Blueprint*
