A limited number of scholarships are available so that youth and young adults with disabilities and/or their family member/personal assistant needing financial assistance can attend Arizona's Eleventh Annual Transition Conference. Scholarships can assist with conference registration fees, lodging costs, or both. The total number of scholarships awarded will be based on available funding and offered on a first-come, first-served basis.

Eligibility:

Eligible applicants must be Arizona residents and must also be a:

- 1. Youth/Young adult between the ages of 14 and 22 years with a documented disability;**
- 2. Family member of a youth/young adult with a disability who is between the ages of 14 and 22 years; or a**
- 3. Personal assistant to a youth/young adult attending the conference.**

Special Notes:

- In the event that requests for scholarships exceed available funding, your name will be placed on a waiting list.
- Scholarship recipients are responsible for their own travel expenses to and from the conference, as well as dinner costs.
- Registration confirmation and hotel approval will be e-mailed to you if your application is approved.
