SUBJECT: 2/1/16 Basic Calculation for Equalization Assistance Report (CHAR 55-1) and Equalization Assistance Detail Report (CHAR 64-1)

The February 1, 2016 charter apportionment is complete. The CHAR55-1 and the CHAR64-1 equalization assistance reports for charters are posted on each charter school's home page of the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) School Finance website at <http://www.azed.gov/districts>. All eligible charters were paid based on their 40th day or 100th day data if the 40th day or 100th was reached January 4, 2016 by 5:00 p.m. The Charter School Student Enrollment Summary report is available for download and review from the School Finance website. Important Notes:

- The February 1st, 2016 apportion of state aid includes the preliminary Charter Additional Assistance lump sum [reduction adjustments](#) for FY 2016. The final will be calculated after the 100th day for all Charters.
- **K-3 Funding:** The funding has been released to eligible district/charter starting in the August 1st payment through equalization payment report (CHAR55-1). To be eligible: must be either letter A or B district/charter **and** the 3rd grade far below reading level is less than 10%. Charters to be considered at the State Board of Education meeting scheduled for 1/22/2016 have been included in the February 1st, 2016 apportionment.
