ProcessorLink Overview SY 2011 - 2012

Fidelis Information Systems Corp., based in Austin, TX, is starting its eighth school year offering ProcessorLink to school districts. ProcessorLink is a web based application that enables manufacturers to track donated food balances for each school district that has diverted commodity pounds to them under the USDA commodity processing program. ProcessorLink tracks donated food for fee for service, rebate, modified fee for service and net off invoice sales options for manufacturers. Paid for by subscribing manufacturers, ProcessorLink provides tremendous benefits to *school districts* including

- Track donated food bank balances with all manufacturers subscribing to ProcessorLink
- Display detailed information on manufacturers' products including nutritional data, ingredients, preparation instructions and other helpful information
- Place orders for fee for service products online through an easy to use but sophisticated order entry feature for *those* manufacturers who have enabled that feature in ProcessorLink
- Receive a monthly statement that displays summary level shipment information on transactions reported by manufacturers and distributors from the prior invoice month
- Assist in verification of delivery of product under the Net Off Invoice sales program by providing school districts a simple and intuitive means of notifying a manufacturer of invalid sales data in a manner that far exceeds the USDA sales verification standards
- Easily locate contact information for both sales and customer service personnel simply by clicking on the logo of a manufacturer, and many more benefits

Overview of Frequently Used Modules and Reports

	<p>ProcessorLink presents the Home Page to the school district user upon successful login into the application. The Home Page provides a wealth of information on</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Each of the school district's donated food accounts with subscribing manufacturer • School district's verification status on sales transactions reported by commercial distributors and manufacturers to ProcessorLink • Single click navigation to most features and reports within the application • Total dollar savings year to date based on the sales transactions reported for all ProcessorLink manufacturers
	<p>Accounts page displays each donated food account in great detail including:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listing donated food carryover, allocation, transfers, shipments and balances in either lbs or currency • Assignment of a commercial distributor to each account • Access the underlying transactions that comprise carryover, allocation and transfers • Quick access to the names and contact information for each manufacturer's sales and customer service staff dedicated to your state • Useful metrics to compare actual usage and target usage and current balance to a target balance based on time of year
	<p>Relevant if you are placing fee for service orders for a ProcessorLink manufacturer which has activated the feature in ProcessorLink. The process is simple.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Click the New link • Select the destination and delivery period and optionally supply a PO Nbr and Comments • Enter case quantities for the relevant products • Click Save

A school district user can verify deliveries by clicking the appropriate month. ProcessorLink will then present for each manufacturer the total cases and discount provided for each product reported for that month and subtotals the total discount for each manufacturer.</p> <p>If the total discount in ProcessorLink matches the paper work from the distributor, the user can simply click the Mark sales as Correct button. If there is a discrepancy, click the link to review each transaction individually at the bottom of each manufacturer section</p>

Note that ProcessorLink has a number of additional reports and modules accessible to school districts but are not described above. These features can be accessed via the single click school district menu located on the right of each page and/or the dropdown menu located at the top of the screen.

ProcessorLink User Account

How to obtain a user account:

- Go to Processorlink.com via your Internet browser
- Click the **Need an account** link located directly under the Login button
- Complete the form by typing directly into each field and save the information by clicking the Submit button

Typically within one business day, Fidelis will approve the user account in ProcessorLink at which time ProcessorLink will email the user the login ID and password from the email account automailer@fidelis-systems.com.

Important note: Should your school district utilize a spam filter, please configure it to allow the receipt of email from the email account automailer@fidelis-systems.com. ProcessorLink not only issues your login ID and password but also transmits a monthly account status from this email account. Please contact your Information Technology department if you are unsure.

Once you receive your credentials to ProcessorLink, simply type your login ID and password in the appropriate fields at ProcessorLink.com and click the Login button. Upon the *first* successful login, ProcessorLink will present an agreement form that should be read and agreed upon.

Feel free to change your password which was randomly generated by ProcessorLink by clicking the Change Password link located in the upper right hand corner of the application once you have logged into the application.

Forgot Password:

Should you forget your password, please click the Forgot Password link located at www.ProcessorLink.com and follow the directions. If the school district user provides the correct information, ProcessorLink will reset the password and communicate this information via the email account automailer@fidelis-systems.com.
