BREAKFAST IN THE CLASSROOM GRANTS AVAILABLE FOR ARIZONA SCHOOLS

Do you want to increase breakfast consumption among schoolchildren and spark the academic and nutritional gains associated with the morning meal through the implementation of Breakfast in the Classroom? Apply today for the Partners for Breakfast in the Classroom grant. The grant is targeted to help high-need school districts and/or schools cover the up-front costs often associated with the start-up and implementation of Breakfast in the Classroom and Grab n' Go programs, such as to purchase equipment, for outreach efforts to parents, program promotion, and other related expenses.

GRANT QUALIFICATIONS

Eligible schools must meet the following criteria:

- 70% of students qualify for Free- or Reduced-Priced (FRP) Meals
- Less than 50% School Breakfast average daily participation (ADP)
- Willingness to serve Breakfast in the Classroom at no charge to all students
- Strong support from Superintendent
- 3-year commitment to making reasonable efforts to continue the program
- Willingness to promote the program
