Availability

Beginning **September 9, 2015**, the **Alternate Assessments** application will be available in ADEConnect.

Description

The Alternate Assessments application is designed to support the administration of the AIMS A Science test, functions for identifying eligible students for both alternate assessments, and monitoring the administration of completion tasks. The Alternate Assessment is based on alternate achievement standards (AA-AAS) for students with the most significant cognitive disabilities.

Roles

Role Name	Permissions in Application
Alternate Assessments – Test Coordinator (District level only)	Allows district administrators to add students to be tested and perform the final closeout procedures <i>This role requires a secondary approval from ADE-Assessments before role is assigned. Please allow 7 days for processing. – See contact information below.</i>
Alternate Assessments – Test Administrator (School level)	Allows teachers to test eligible students
Alternate Assessments – Reviewer (All levels)	Allows users to review the testing forms and/or test items. <i>This role requires a secondary approval from ADE-Assessments before role is assigned. Please allow 7 days for processing. – See contact information below.</i>
