SELECTING AN EXPENSE CATEGORY

Click Enter Expense to begin an expense entry, and choose a category from the pop-menu (shown below):



* Items marked with an asterisk are specific to students with disabilities and are covered on Page 2.

- 530 Coverdell Plan: Direct deposits into a 530 account. Please note that transferring money from a 529 is not allowed.
- Curricula and Supplemental Materials: Select this option for:
 - Curricula purchased with or without out supplemental materials
 - Supplemental materials for previously-purchased curricula that is already entered into the system
 - Supplemental materials for previously-purchased curricula that is not entered into the system
- ESA Bank Fees: Fees accrued when obtaining a replacement ESA card
- Online Private Program Expenses: Classes at a private-online school or program
- Postsecondary Institution Expenses: Attendance at a college, community college, or trade school
- Private School Expenses: Tuition, books, fees, and uniforms paid directly to a private school
- Public School Tuition Expenses: Tuition for programs or activities hosted by a public school
- Testing Fees: College admissions testing fees (e.g. SAT or ACT) or purchased practice tests for a future testing date
- Tutoring Services: Teaching services provided by an accredited and qualified person or provider

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES - ADDITIONAL CATEGORIES



The following expense categories are only available to students with disabilities:

- Assistive Technology Rental: Rental fees for assistive technology that is required in order to complete educational courses
- **Educational Therapies and Services:** Educational therapies or services specific to student's individual educational needs (speech therapy, occupational therapy, music therapy, etc.)
- Paraprofessional Services: Services from a qualified paraprofessional
- Vocational / Life Skills Education: Classes required for basic day-to-day functioning
