

### SPED72 – SPED Participation Report

The SPED72 (SPED Participation Report) displays all students with SPED Needs and/or SPED Program Participation and whether or not they have passed FED SPED and State SPED integrity.

**Note:** Select a **Fiscal Year** and **Local Education Agency** in the upper-right corner before running the report

**(1) Reporting Parameters:** Users must choose a Fiscal Year and Local Education Agency, District of Attendance/Residence, a School or Schools from the drop-down menus.

- The **Page Break between Schools** check box displays each school on a separate page. This is only applicable for users with permissions to view submissions from multiple schools.

**(2) View Report:** Queries results (shown on Page 2).

**(3) Collapse:** To provide more room for viewing the report, the - button collapses the interface:

**(4) Expand:** Click the + icon of a collapsed report to expand the search interface.

**(5) PDF/CSV/Print:** Selecting **PDF** prompts to save or open the report as a PDF file. Selecting **CSV** prompts to save or open the report as an Excel document. Selecting **Print** displays the report in a print preview window. Click the printer icon to print the report as it appears on the screen.

**(6) Search:** Type the name of entity, or part of a name, to quickly scan the report. Matches are highlighted blue.

**(7) Navigation:** The ◀ and ▶ buttons move forward and backward, one page at a time. The ⏪ and ⏩ buttons move to the first and last page, respectively. A specific page number can be entered in the textbox, followed by hitting Enter on the keyboard.



# ADE Quick Reference Guides

## AzEDS Reports



- **FED SPED Pass/Fail:** Indicates whether or not the student passed the FED SPED Integrity Rules or not
- **State SPED Pass/Fail:** Indicates whether or not the student passed the State SPED Integrity Rules or not

**(11) Need / SPED Program Participation Information** – The following information is listed per student:

- **Need:** The SPED Need Code reported
- **Need Entry Date:** The SPED Need Entry Date associated with the Need Code
- **Need Exit Date:** The SPED Need Exit Date associated with the Need Code
- **FED Primary Need:** Indicates whether the need receiving services was marked as the Primary Need
- **Svc Code:** The SPED Program Service Code reported
- **Svc Entry Date:** The Entry Date associated with the SPED Program Service Code
- **Svc Exit Date:** The Exit Date associated with the SPED Program Service Code
- **SPED Exit Code:** The Exit Code associated with the SPED Program Service Code/Exit Date
- **Primary/Secondary School:** Indicates whether the service-providing school is the Primary (P) or Secondary (S) school

**Note:** When results are exported to CSV, two additional columns are shown for the Student Need Resource ID and the Student Program Resource ID:
