Winslow High School

Winslow High School is situated on the border of the Navajo Nation in Winslow, Arizona. All students create a Senior Capstone Portfolio as a graduation requirement. This portfolio contains college and career planning tools like worksheets on postsecondary financial planning, resumes, letters of recommendation, job-shadowing reflections, and interest inventories.

Chino Valley High School

Northern Arizona’s Chino Valley High School believes “success begins with a CVHS diploma.” Counselors work closely with every student to develop personalized plans that engage students in the ECAP process, promote graduation, and foster postsecondary success.



ECAP Process Overview

- Counselors meet individually with students to explore career goals and develop four-year and postsecondary education plans
- Early identification of at-risk students to be placed on credit recovery
- ECAP lessons (English & social studies classrooms)
