

Integrity Error -40055

Error Message:

Invalid exit code combination; refer to the SPED Exit Validation matrix.

Description:

If a student's SPED Exit Reason does not align with the student's enrollment year-end or withdrawal enrollment status, then report the discrepancy as an error. This rule will be re-run beginning May 1st of the fiscal year to capture misalignment and unreported. (Refer to SPED Exit Validation matrix)

Troubleshooting:

- Verify LRE and Enrollment Exit Codes.
- AzEDS SPED Codes Reference Document
- Verify reported LRE and Enrollment Exit Codes align with the SPED Exit Validation matrix.
- SPED Exit Validation matrix
- Beginning May 1st of each Fiscal Year, -40055 will check for four elements and will fail if not reported:
 - SPED Exit Date, SPED Exit Reason, Enrollment Exit Date, Enrollment Exit Reason
 - Data must be entered in all four elements to pass -40055 after May 1st.
- Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72 report. A listing of all Integrity Rules can be found on the <u>AzEDS website</u>.
