



### Integrity Error -40055

#### Error Message:

Invalid exit code combination; refer to the SPED Exit Validation matrix.

#### Description:

If a student's SPED Exit Reason does not align with the student's enrollment year end or withdrawal enrollment status, then report the discrepancy as an error. This rule will be re-run beginning May 1st of the fiscal year to capture misalignment and unreported. (Refer to SPED Exit Validation matrix)

#### Example:

- SPED
  - LRE Exit Reason
- Enrollment
  - Exit Reason

Starting May 1<sup>st</sup> each FY

The cells contain 'Y' for allowed, 'N' for not allowed, and 'N/A' for not applicable.

- Beginning May 1<sup>st</sup> of each Fiscal Year, -40055 will check for four elements and will fail if not reported:
  - SPED Exit Date, SPED Exit Reason, Enrollment Exit Date, Enrollment Exit Reason
  - Data must be entered in all four elements to pass -40055 after May 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72 report.
