

### Integrity Error -40071


**Error Message:**

SPED Exit code 10 may only be used for student 3-5 yrs old, enrolled in PS, KG or UE grade, and exited from enrollment on same date.

**Description:**

Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) exit code 10 (Withdrawn by Parent and no Longer enrolled) can only be used if the student is 3 to 5 years old, and enrolled in Preschool (PS), Kindergarten (KG), or Ungraded Elementary (UE).

**Troubleshooting:**

- Verify correct LRE Exit date and LRE Exit Reason are reported.
- If the student does not meet the criteria for SPED Exit 10, select a new allowable exit code based the SPED Exit Validation matrix.

- Verify enrollment exit date matches SPED exit date.
- Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72
