Description of Credentials	The American Red Cross First Aid, CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation), and AED (Automated external defibrillator) credential meets the needs of OSHA workplace responders, professional rescuers and responders, and healthcare providers. In this instructor-led course you will learn how to respond to first air, breathing and cardiac emergencies. In the classroom, you will have the opportunity to learn from and interact with a Red Cross Instructor who will guide you through hands-on practice of lifesaving skills. Success students will receive a certificate of Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED valid for two years.
