Description of Credentials	<p>OSHA 10- The OSHA Outreach Training Program provides training for entry-level workers and employers on the recognition, avoidance, abatement, and prevention of safety and health hazards in workplaces. The program also provides information regarding workers' rights, employer responsibilities, and how to file a complaint. Through this training, OSHA helps to ensure that workers are more knowledgeable about workplace hazards and their rights.</p> <p>CareerSafe offers four variations of the OSHA 10 training-General Industry, Construction Industry, General Industry-Healthcare, General Industry-Agriculture.</p> <p>Students who successfully complete a CareerSafe® OSHA 10-Hour General Industry, Construction Industry, General Industry-Healthcare or a General Industry-Agriculture course receive an OSHA 10-Hour wallet card from the OSHA Training Institute (OTI).</p>

Industry-Based Certification Requirements: Students						
Standard / Curriculum	<p>The 10-hour course includes 13 modules as part of the requirement including Introduction to OSHA (Part 1) Introduction to OSHA (Part 2). Each module contains a brief assessment which must be successfully completed before the student can move on to the next module. Once all modules have been viewed and the corresponding assessments are passed there is a comprehensive final assessment.</p> <p>The estimated seat time for this course is 10 hours.</p>

Re-Testing (if available)	Re-Testing Procedures	If the student is unable to pass a topic assessment within the required 3 times, they will be allowed one additional attempt but must repeat the topic module. If a student is unable to pass the final assessment within 3 attempts the student can receive one free reset of the course. But the course must be started over from the beginning. See Testing Details below		Max Attempts	3 attempts within 6 months	

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Testing Details (including any age requirements / accommodations)	Students must satisfy all requirements prior to receiving the OSHA 10-Hour Industry wallet card which include: Must pass all assessments with a grade of 70% or higher. If the student is unable to pass a topic assessment within the required 3 times, they will be allowed one additional attempt but must repeat the topic module. If a student is unable to pass the final assessment within 3 attempts the student can receive one free reset of the course. But the course must be started over from the beginning. Must complete the course within six (6) months from the course enrollment date. Must spend a minimum of two (2) days taking the course with no more than 7 1/2 hours (450 Minutes) in a single day. Must view and complete all required course material, including the course survey.

Proctoring / Test Security (if any)	All tests proctored through the CareerSafe Online programs Learning Management System (LMS) and all students' grades are automatically uploaded within their teacher's CareerSafe gradebook. Other online companies' policies will vary with the training agency.
