Characteristics of culturally responsive instruction

- Relevant to students
- Provides authentic contexts for learning
- Engages parents and community
- Leverages students' funds of knowledge
- Connects disciplinary knowledge and skills to student identities
- Built on trusting, caring relationships
- Encourages student ownership of learning
- Scaffolds participation and communication structures
- Encourages critical discourse
