After 2nd time not passing, student must wait 5 days. A five-day waiting period will be imposed for each subsequent exam retake. This policy applies to both voucher-based and site-license-based Certiport Centers. If a retake option was purchased with the voucher, a retake voucher is sent by email after a failed exam. Have at least one-year experience teaching. 3. Clearly understand the content framework in the Industry Standards documents of ACI.
