We are happy to announce the state legislature appropriated \$1,000,000 for FY20 to fund the state Gifted Education grant to help support Gifted Education programs and services in your district or charter LEA.

FY20 Gifted Education Grant Opportunity

The purpose of the Gifted Education grant is to provide LEAs with the opportunity to apply for additional funding per ARS §15.779.03 to supplement their efforts to provide Gifted Education programs and services for their identified gifted students K-12, as applicable, in alignment with approved LEA Scope and Sequences for Gifted Education Programs.

Funds expended through this grant program must be used to supplement, and not supplant, monies from other sources (ARS §15.779.03(C)).

FY20 Gifted Education Grant Timeline

Grant budget can support activities through June 30, 2020

• **Project Period:** July 1, 2019 – June 30,2020

• Applications Available: July 15, 2019

• Application Due Date: September 6, 2019



FY20 Gifted Education Grant Eligibility

To receive these funds, your LEA (traditional school districts and charter holders) must:

Have a current governing board and Arizona Department of Education approved Scope and Sequence for Gifted Education Programs as required by ARS §15-779.02.

Comply with ARS §15-779.01, Arizona State Board of Education Rule R7-2-406 and serve all eligible gifted students in grades K-12, as applicable.

Submit evidence, through assuring in your application, that teachers who have primary responsibility for teaching gifted students have obtained or are working towards obtaining the gifted education endorsement.

FY20 Gifted Education Grant Eligibility

If your LEA has an FY20 Gifted Education Grant Allocation, then your LEA is eligible to apply for funds through this grant program



FY20 Gifted Education Grant Allocations

Allocations for the Gifted Education Grant are calculated per the following statutory formula (ARS §15-779.03(A): "seventy-five dollars per pupil for four per cent of the district's student count, or two thousand dollars, whichever is more"

The allocation formula has been adjusted to match the total amount available for LEA Assistance (\$950,000)

The final per pupil amount is now \$19.38 for 4% of an eligible LEAs student count (SY18-19 ADM), or \$2,000 – whichever is greater

The FY20 Gifted Education Grant application may be accessed through the ADE Grants Management system at **gme.azed.gov**

You will need to sign in to the Grants Management system using your **ADEConnect** login information to access the application. Access to the Grants Management system may need to be granted to you by your local LEA ADEConnect Entity Administrator.

15-779.01. Powers and duties of the school district governing board

Because it is in the public interest to support unique opportunities for high-achieving and underachieving pupils who are identified as gifted, the governing board of each school district shall provide gifted education to gifted pupils identified as provided in this article.

The governing board shall modify the course of study and adapt teaching methods, materials and techniques to provide educationally for those pupils who are gifted and possess superior intellect or advanced learning ability, or both, but may have an educational disadvantage resulting from a disability or a difficulty in writing, speaking or understanding the English language due to an environmental background in which a language other than English is primarily or exclusively spoken. Identification of gifted pupils as provided in this subsection shall be based on tests or subtests that are demonstrated to be effective with special populations including those with a disability or difficulty with the English language.

If a pupil who was previously identified as a gifted pupil by a school district or charter school transfers into another school district, the school district into which the pupil transferred shall determine in a timely manner whether the pupil shall be identified as a gifted pupil in that school district. The school district into which the pupil transferred shall provide gifted education to transfer pupils who are identified as gifted without unreasonable delay.

Examples of Non-Allowable Expenditures

- Standard desks and chairs capital items
- Student field trips, on their own, would not an allowable expenditure.

Funds should be used to expand, enhance or extend existing efforts, and/or to engage in new activities to support the local implementation of gifted education programs and services
