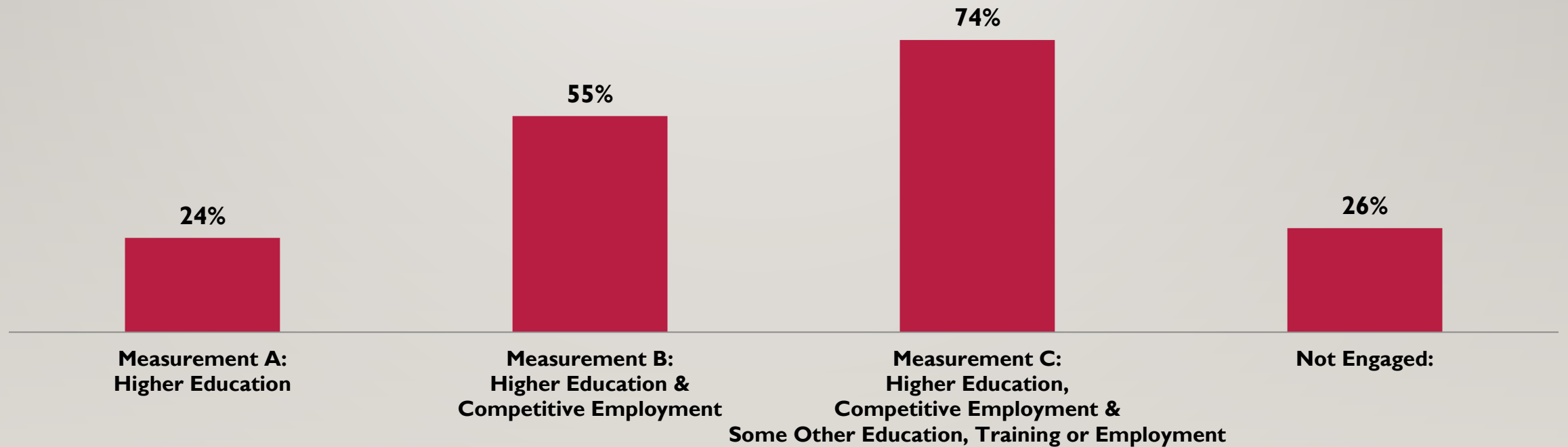

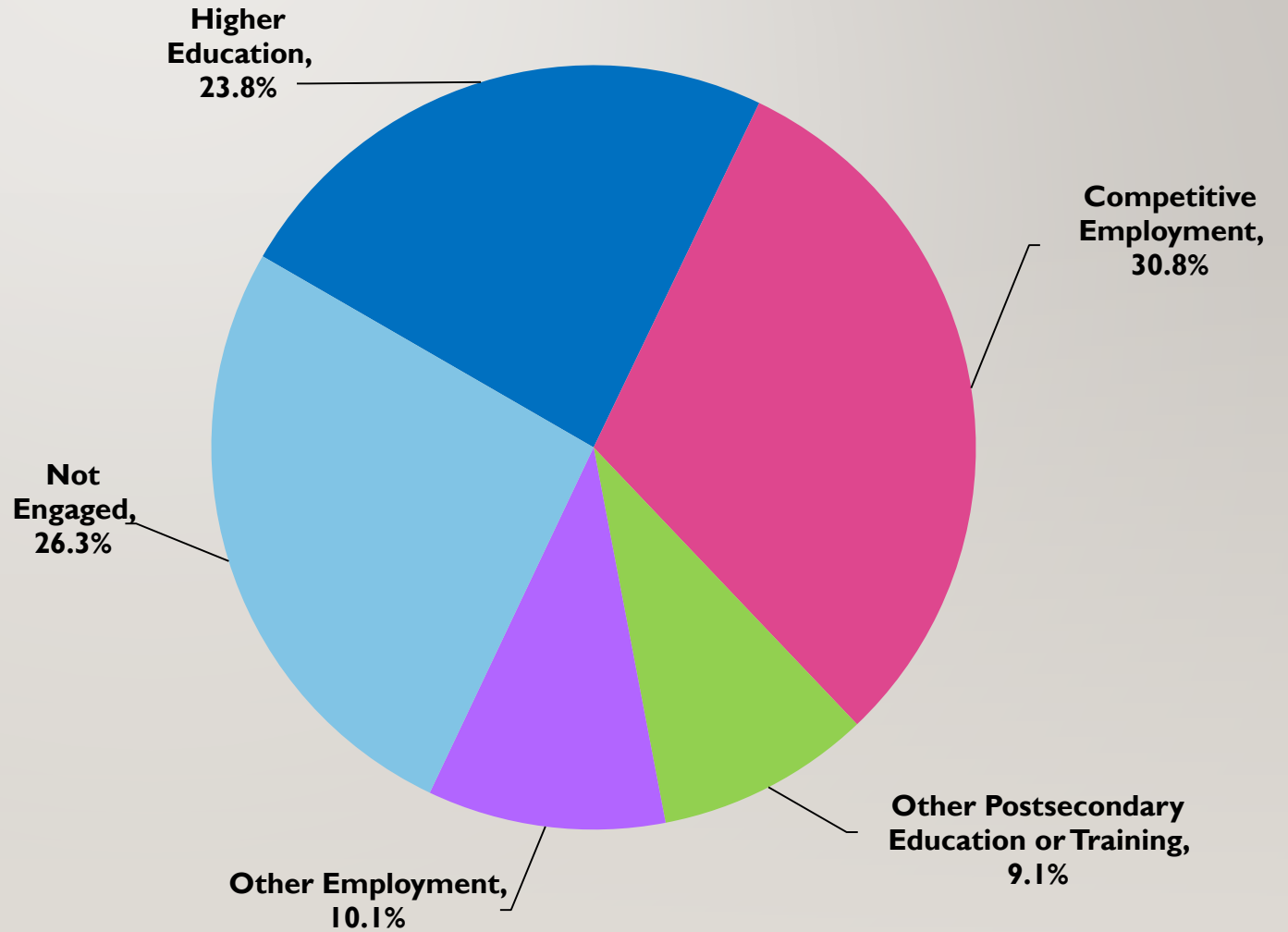
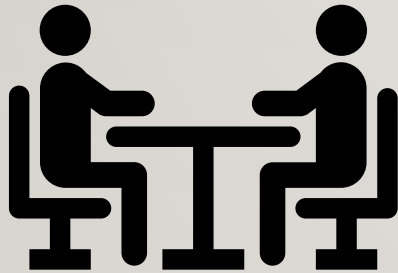

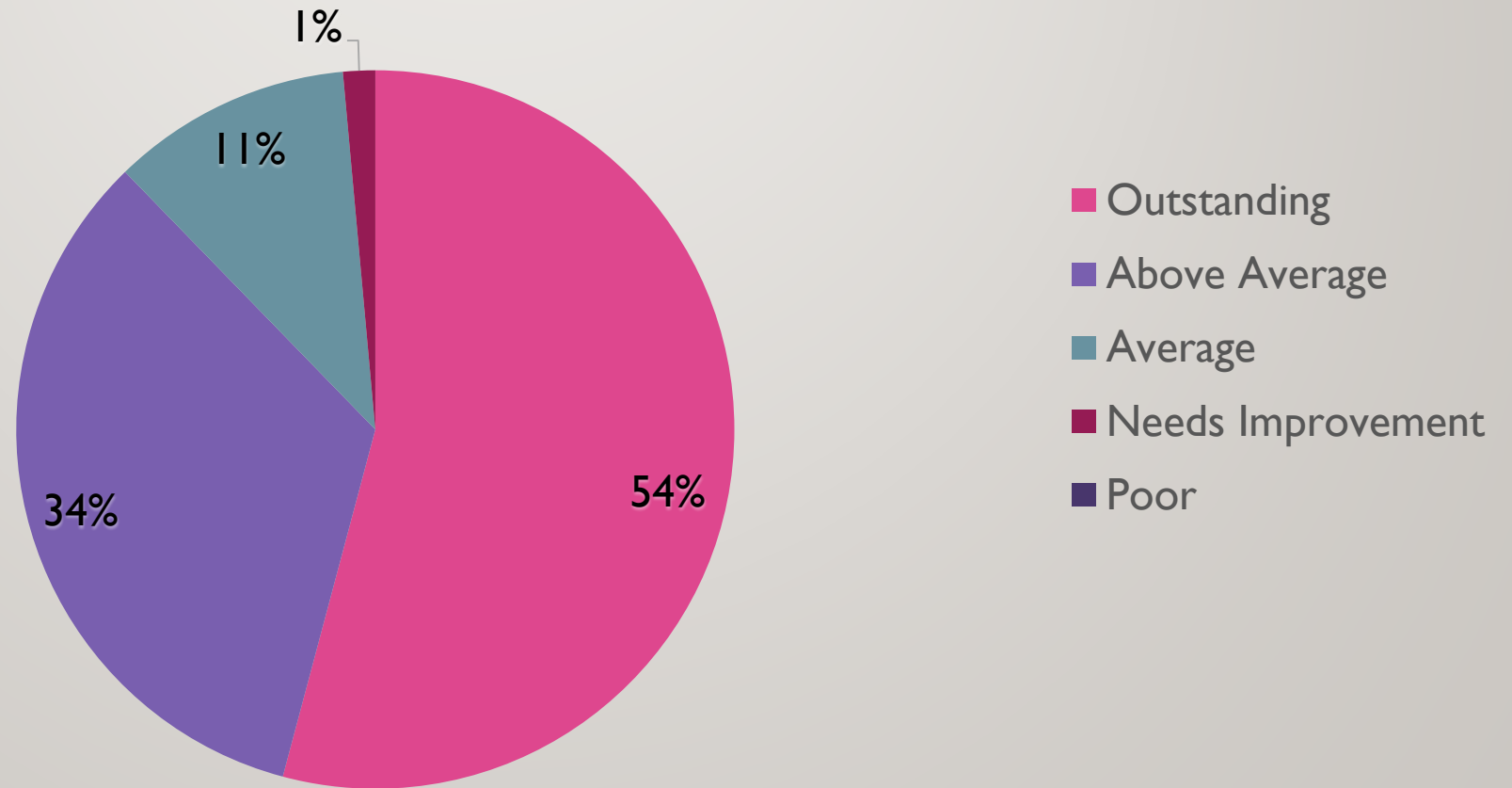

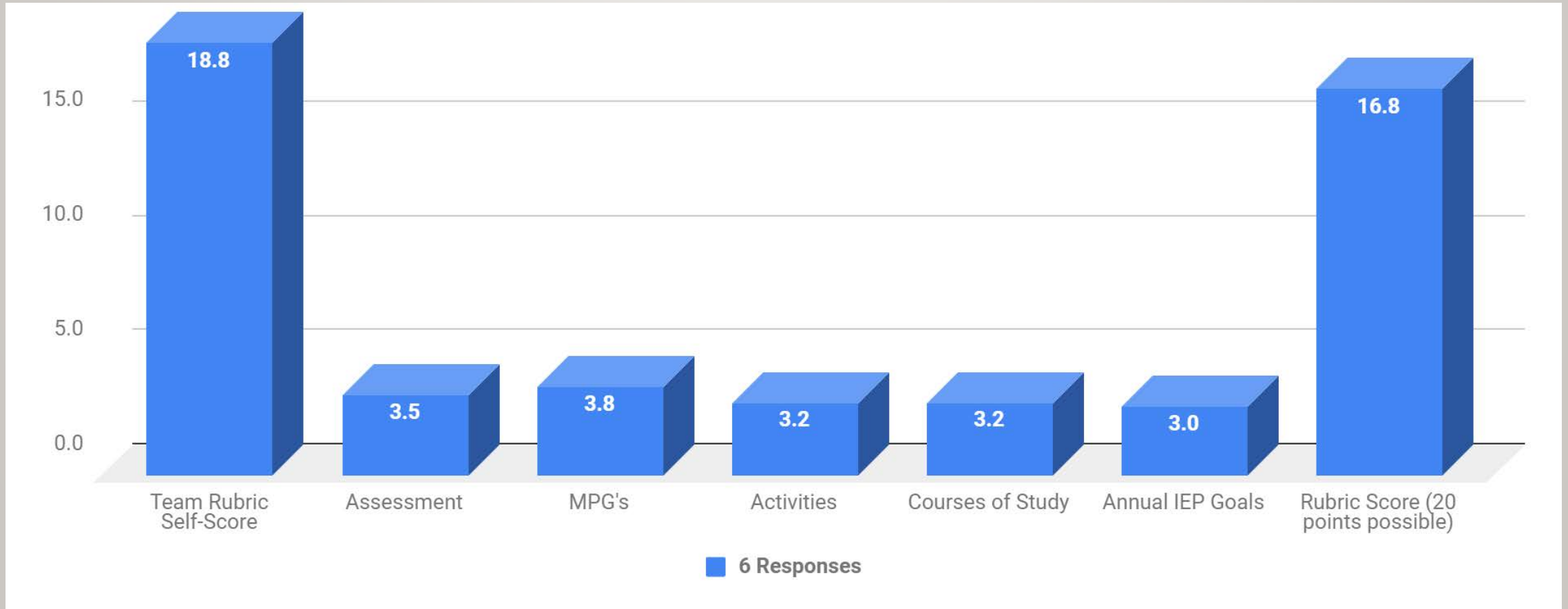

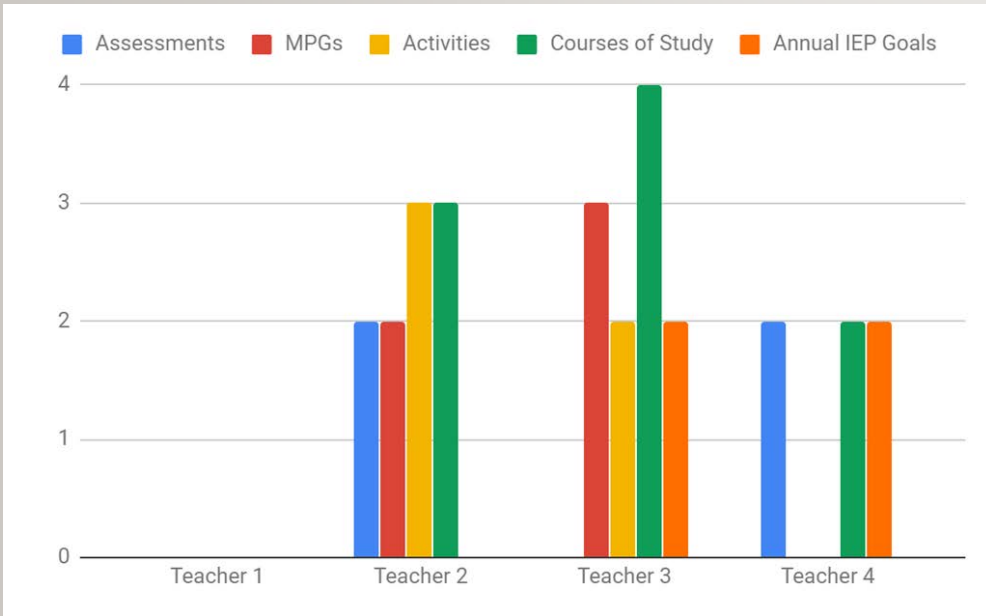


Regional Training Feedback to Participants



Targeted Training Process For 2019-2020

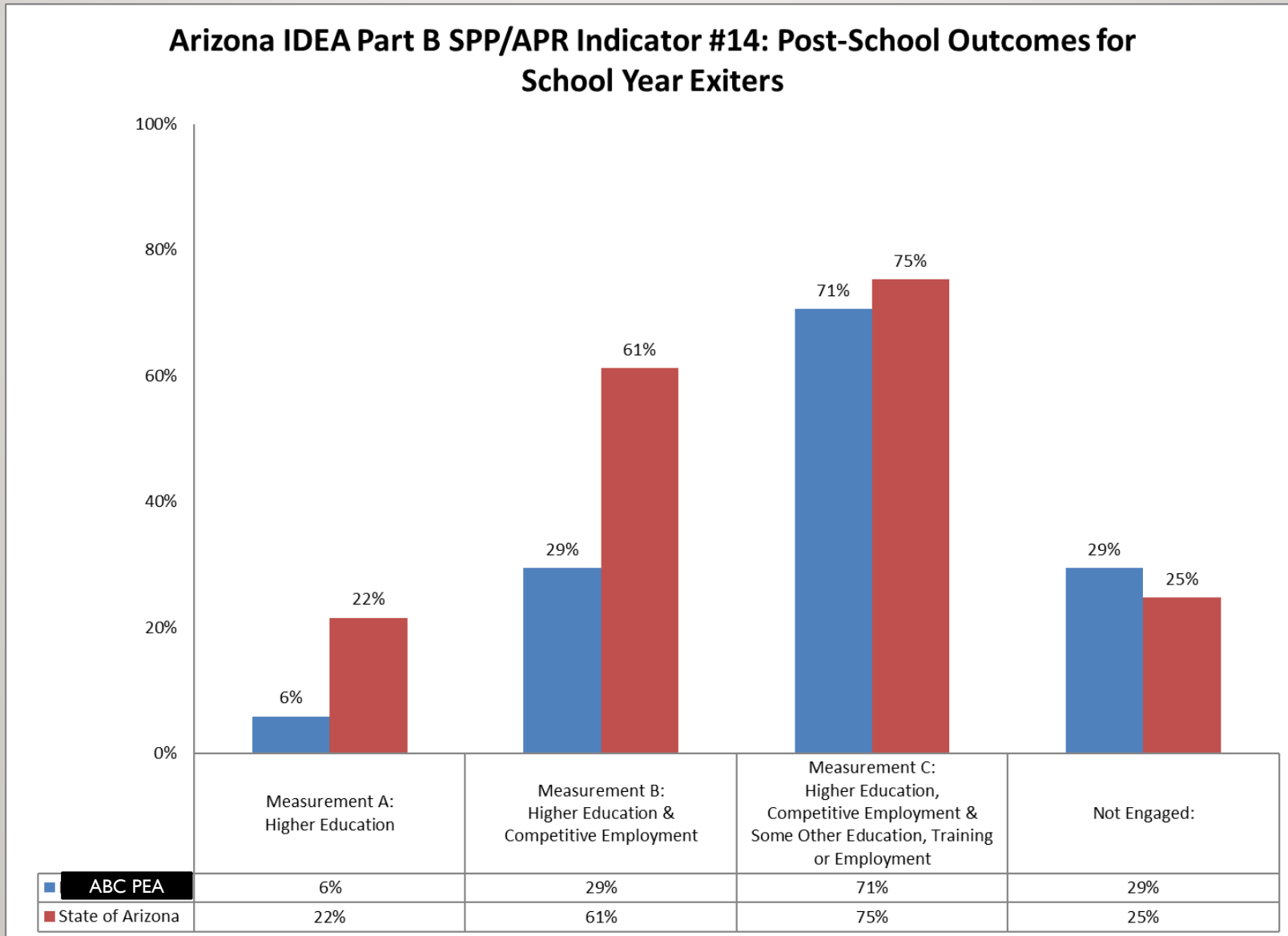

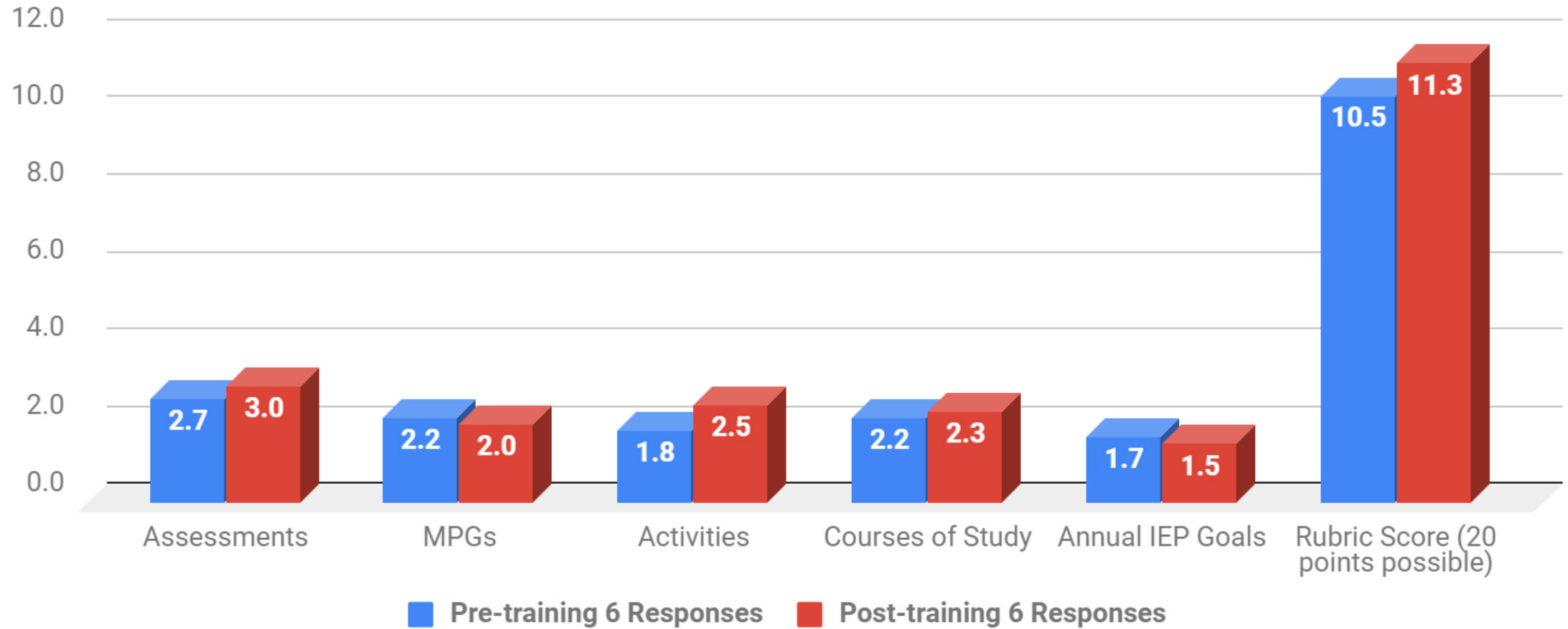

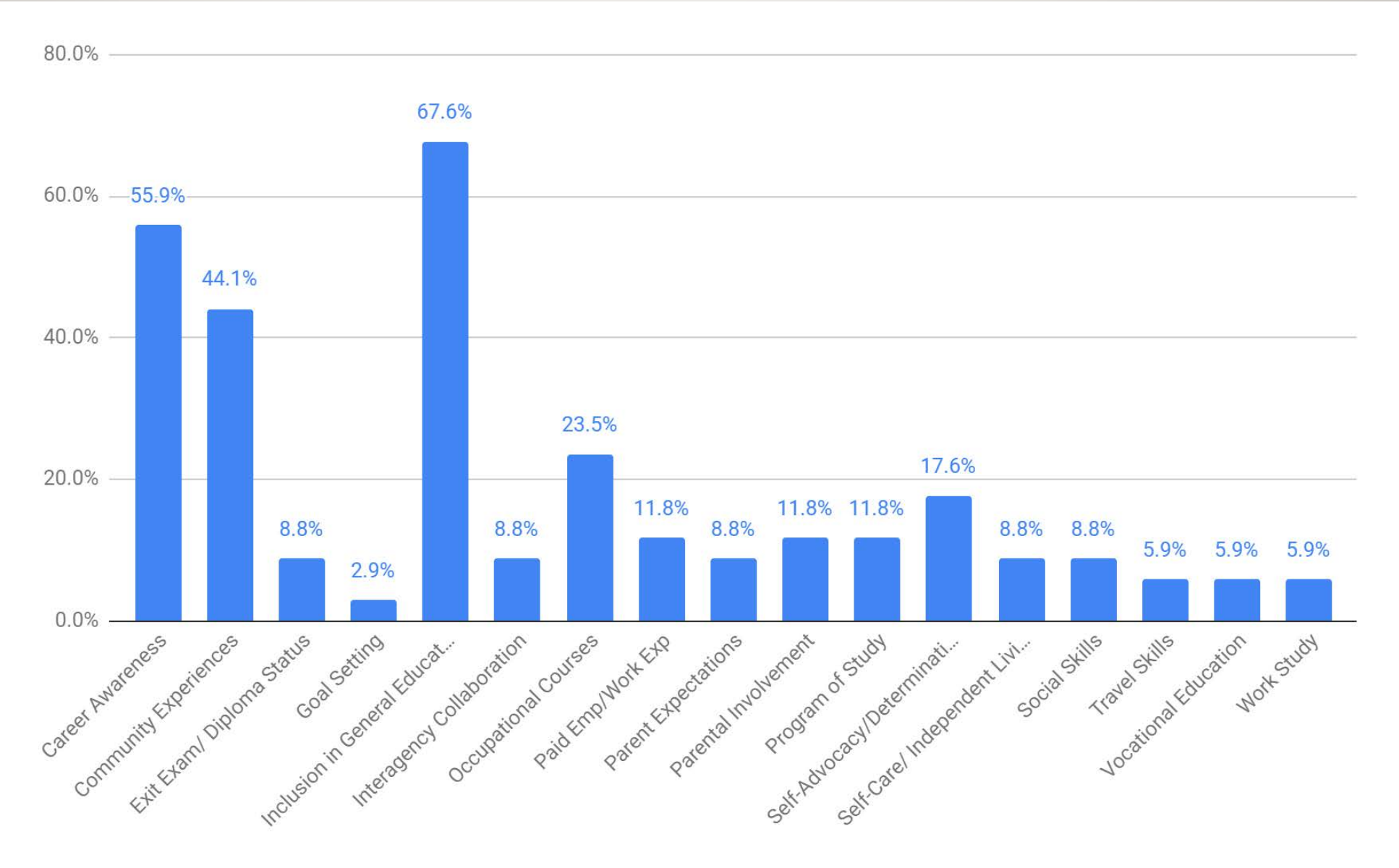
