- Submitted the Close Out Survey for the 2020 Farm to Summer Challenge by July 31, 2020 and;
- Submitted evidence of their Taste Arizona Challenge (Menu and/or Production Record) July 31, 2020 and;
- Shared at least one source of evidence that the 2020 Farm to Summer Challenge happened. This can be a social media post, a link to a news article or website talking about the SFSP Sponsor's Challenge, mailed photos and/or a newspaper article showing how the Challenge was marked to the SFSP Sponsor's community. This must be submitted to ADE by July 31, 2020. Postmark

SFSP Reviewers will consider the following criteria points for Top Performance Awards:

Taste Arizona (MAX points = 10) SFSP Sponsors must serve at least three “local” SFSP reimbursable meal components. This is identified in the closing feedback survey, menu and/or production record submitted by July 31,2020.

- **Gold** (MAX 10 points): SFSP challengers can count any three reimbursable SFSP meal components as part of their Challenge outside of fluid milk. One of the three, must include a grain, meat/meat alternative or cheese/yogurt.
- **Silver** (MAX 7 points): SFSP challengers can count any three reimbursable SFSP meal components as part of their Challenge *including* locally sourced fluid milk. One of the three, must include a grain, meat/meat alternative or cheese/yogurt.
- **Copper** (MAX 5 points): SFSP challengers can count any three reimbursable SFSP meal components as part of their Challenge *including* locally sourced fluid milk. This can include a fruit, vegetable or fluid milk. Multiple varieties of any fruit or vegetable can count toward multiple locally sourced SFSP meal components.

Teach Arizona (MAX points = 5/6) SFSP Sponsors must offer at least two education events or activities that teach students about where their food came from. This can include, but it no limited to: inviting a farmer to lunch, taste-based education (or taste testing), visiting the school garden, visiting a farm, nutrition or agriculture lesson, pen-paling with a farmer, guest presentation from a commodity association, chef demo, culinary class, reading an agriculture book or learning about Arizona’s agricultural industry.

- More than two events/activities per participating site = 6
- At least two events/activities per participating site = 5
- At least one event/activity per participating site = 3

Connect Arizona (MAX points = 5/7) SFSP Sponsors must share at least one social media or share one alternative media outlet indicating their invitation to the community about their 2020 Farm to Summer Week Challenge.

- If more than one post was shared and included was a photo of the student’s tray or SFSP meal served= 7
- More than one post or media outlet was shared = 6
- At least one post or media outlet was shared = 5

Disclaimer: Special consideration for one of the three Top Performance Awards will be reserved for communities that predominately serve immigrant, Native American, rural-located, communities of color and/or serve a community that meets 95% or higher Free and Reduced Priced Meals.

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
