

Integrity Error -40073

Error Message:

Only SPED Exit Codes may be used to exit a SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE).

Description:

If the exit code used for SPED Least Restrictive Environment (LRE) is not a SPED Exit Code, then report the discrepancy as an error.

Example:

- SPED
 - LRE
 - Exit Reason
- ➔
- 40073
Is the Exit Code a
SPED Exit Code?

If the exit reason code submitted for a SPED LRE is not a SPED Exit Reason Code (SPEDxx) the rule will fail. This can commonly occur when code descriptions are similar to other, non-sped, exit codes. Refer to AzEDS SPED Codes document for valid SPED Exit Reason codes.

Troubleshooting:

- Verify correct LRE Exit date and LRE Exit Reason are reported.
- If the student is not reported with a valid SPED Exit Code, refer to the AzEDS SPED Codes document for valid SPED Exit Reason codes.

- Once corrected, allow integrity to run overnight to see if student is passing integrity on SPED72 report.
