ESY Compared to Compensatory Educational Services

	Extended School Year Services (ESY)	Compensatory Education Services
Guided by:	Specifically addressed in IDEA, Arizona Revised Statute, and State Board Rule	Not outlined in IDEA, but is supported as an equitable remedy through federal case law
Purpose:	Is a component of a FAPE and an IEP team is required to consider the need for ESY as part of the IEP process	Equitable remedy developed after a failure or inability to provide a FAPE as outlined in an IEP. Public education agencies (PEAs) create an offer of compensatory educational services utilizing the totality of the circumstances, including input from the parent.
When:	Typically provided during summer, but can be provided at other school breaks	Can be provided during summer, during the school year, during school breaks, before school, after school, etc.
How:	Determined by the IEP team, which includes the parent	Determined by the PEA with input from parents
How:	Individualized based upon student need; not a one-size-fits-all approach	Individualized based upon student need; not a one-size-fits-all approach

3 Dos and 2 Don'ts for ESY

As documented in LRP May 8, 2020

Do

- provide ESY services
- collect 4th quarter progress data
- communicate with parents

Don't

- offer ESY to all students
- confuse ESY with comp ed services

Other Things to Think About

In the event an ESY determination was not made before the 45-day requirement, determine the need and provide services in accordance with the determination

Have a backup plan in the event that in-person services are not safe and/or feasible at any point

Remember to use multifaceted eligibility criteria for ESY

Remember, ESY is not the same for all students who are eligible
