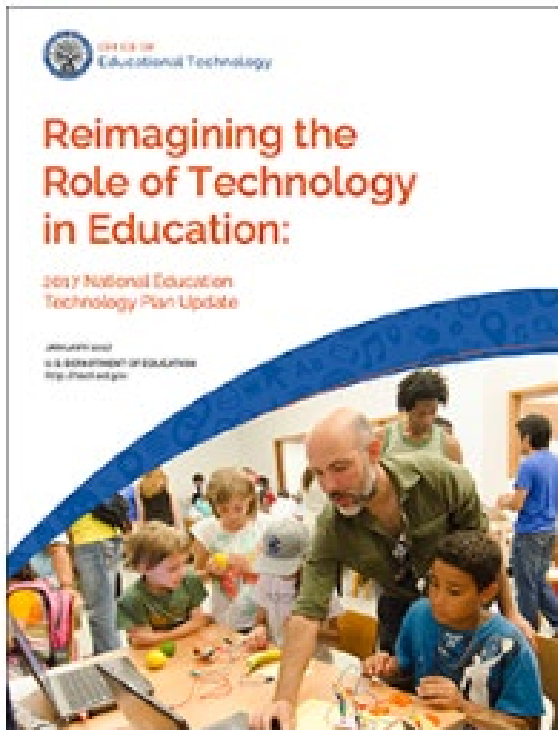

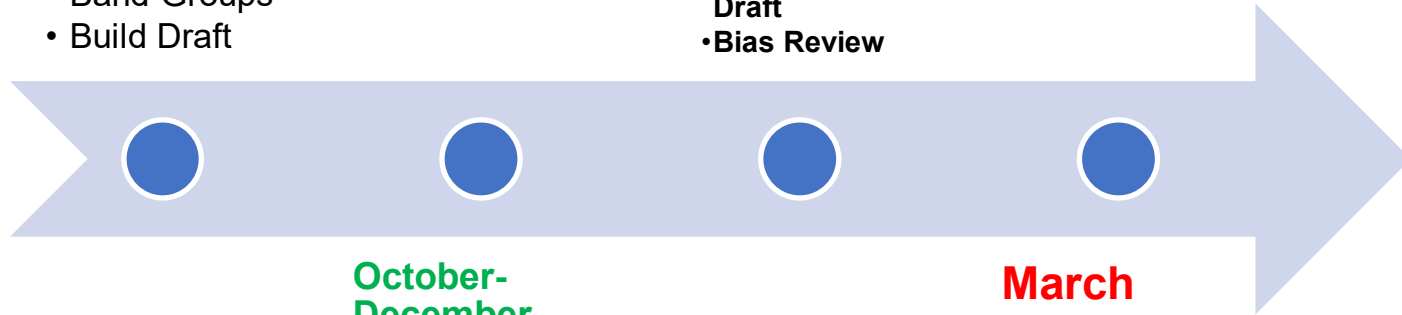

Process to Creating Ed. Tech. Standards

1. Priority - Arizona Educator Involvement
2. Based on Research
3. Based on ISTE Standards
4. Utilize other state ed. Tech standards
5. ***Link with any current state initiatives***

#5 – Could evolve over the summer

Process to Creating Ed. Tech. Standards

1. Large group meetings – 25- 30 people (rotate through committee members)
 - Small groups of 4-5 for each grade level band

In the past meetings have been mainly face to face meetings. The Ed. Tech Work group will begin with virtual meetings at the end of August/September.

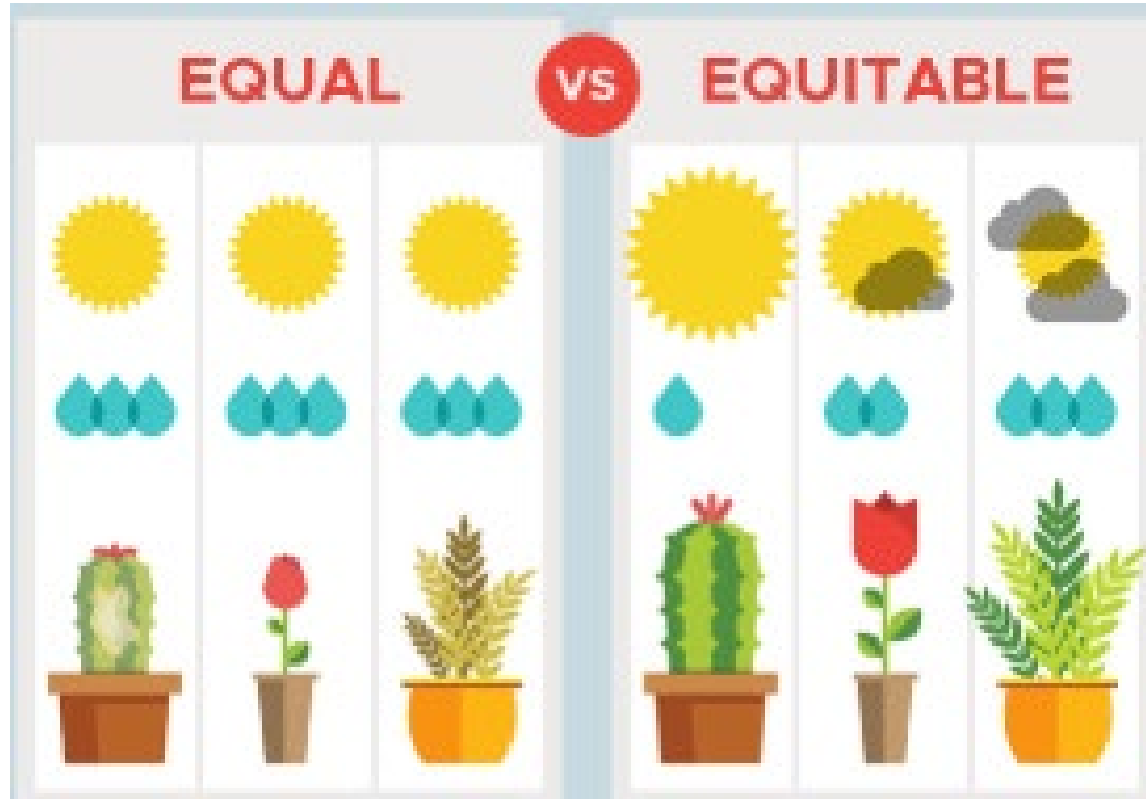
