Comments/Recommendations:

Espiritu Community Development Corp. Administrative Review findings revealed a systemic error in the counting and claiming system, and thus, a fiscal recalculation is necessary. Errors were consistently found with Breakfast in the Classroom and Lunch meal counts. The fiscal recalculation will be based on meal count data from an error-free period of 30 consecutive operating days. This data will be used to recalculate the reimbursement previously received based on erroneous claims. It is imperative that the 30 days of meal counts reflects the corrective action implemented to yield an accurate meal counting and claiming system. If errors are still present, this process will continue until the errors have been resolved.

Due to SY19/20 COVID-19 school closures, Espiritu Community Development Corp. will be unable to provide 30 consecutive operating days of meal counts and the recalculation of meal counts will not be able to be completed. Reyes Maria Ruiz Leadership Academy provision 2 base year administrative review will remain open until 30 consecutive operating days of breakfast in the classroom meal counts are received and fiscal action can be determined for Espiritu Community Development Corp.
